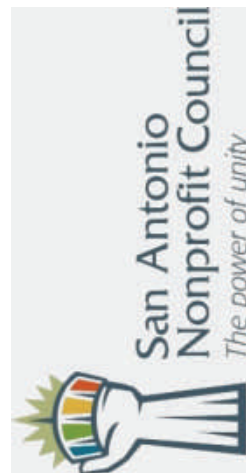


## Learning Objectives:

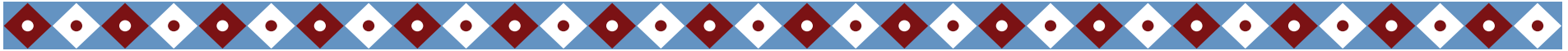

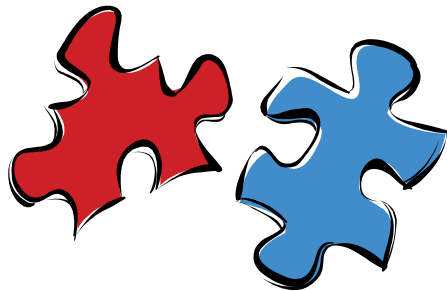
